Description: This course is designed to provide local and state-level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities and capabilities of an effective DIVS on an AHIMT. The course walks students through general information, including an overview of the Operations Section and information on incident mobilization, initial situation awareness and unit management. It also provides detailed instruction on responding to the incident and the command needs of the incident, as well as emphasizing the importance of risk management and safety considerations.

Prerequisites: Successful completion of **IS-100:** Introduction to ICS, **IS-200:** Basic ICS, **IS-700:** NIMS, An Introduction, **IS-800:** National Response Framework, **ICS-300:** Intermediate ICS are **required**. **ICS400:** Advanced ICS is *recommended*.

Target Audience: NIMS ICS Position Specific training should be completed by personnel who are regularly assigned to functional, support, or unit leader positions on USFA or other Type III All-Hazards Incident Management Teams (AHIMT), or by those persons who desire to seek credentials/certification in those positions.

Additional Information: All who enroll will initially be listed as "Pending Host Approval" until their eligibility as a primary stakeholder in this training can be confirmed, and all additional paperwork is received by our office. Attendees for this class must be identified as part of the target audience. Eligibility will be reviewed on a weekly basis. Priority will be given to Region IX enrollments.

Open enrollment for this course will start January 27, 2012.

Eligible candidates **MUST** also submit the following documents:
